**Once again it has come to the attention of Ray Nkonyeni Municipality that some rouge elements are luring desperate job seekers with promises to secure employment for a fee.**

Following advertisement of several positions a few weeks ago, some rouge elements and scammers are luring applicants through promising them to secure employment in exchange of a fee, referred to as 'idrinki'. We would like to caution members of the public that in terms of recruitment policy, the municipality follows a transparent, legal process which involves scanning and shortlisting of applications as per job requirement and as advertised. Those procedures are then followed by a process of interviews after which successful candidates are appointed.

At no stage is anyone required to pay for any position, and any person who purports to be in a position to deliver any job through exchange of money is not telling the truth. The public is warned not to fall for such scams, and in fact, we strongly encourage such individuals to be reported to the nearest police station or call our Anti-Fraud and Corruption Hotline 0801 111 660 or the Presidential Hotline 17737
